They have a fascinating life cycle, starting as an egg, then becoming a nymph (a baby bug) and finally growing into an adult silverfish. These little creatures can live for up to eight years, which is pretty long for a bug!

But what do these nocturnal wigglers eat and where do they hang out? Silverfish have a pretty varied diet which includes sugar, hair, dandruff and even glue! You can often find them in damp, dark places in your home, like your basement, bathroom or under the kitchen sink. They also love paper and fabric, so watch out for your books and clothes!



Now, how do these teardrop-shaped critters interact with others? While they don't pose a direct threat to humans or pets, they can be a nuisance due to their love for munching on household items. In terms of defenses, silverfish are pretty good at running away and hiding when they sense danger. So next time you see a shiny, wiggling critter scurrying away, remember, it might just be a silverfish, a fascinating little creature with a long lifespan and a taste for the sweeter things in life.
