- 3) While on vacation, Sarah took seventeen pictures at the zoo and twenty-one at the museum. If she later deleted twenty-four of the pictures, how many pictures from her vacation did she still have?
- 4) George had to wash fifteen short sleeve shirts and fifteen long sleeve shirts before school. If he had only washed four of them by the time school started, how many did he not wash?
- 5) The school cafeteria ordered eighteen red apples and thirty-five green apples for student's lunches. But, if only twenty-three students wanted fruit, how many extra did the cafeteria end up with?
- 6) Maria had thirty-three music files and thirty-five video files on her flash drive. If she deleted eleven of the files, how many files were still on her flash drive?
- 7) Haley picked forty-nine tulips and ten roses to make flower bouquets. If she only used twenty-eight of the flowers though, how many extra flowers did Haley pick?
- 8) Tiffany and her mom were picking carrots from their garden. Tiffany picked thirty-six and her mother picked ten. If only seven of the carrots were good, how many bad carrots did they have?
- 9) Paige bought two coloring books. One had five pictures and the other had nine. After one week she had already colored two of the pictures. How many pictures does she still have to color?
- 10) Oliver was trying to expand his game collection. He bought twenty-seven games from a friend and bought twenty-two more at a garage sale. If seventeen of the games didn't work, how many good games did he end up with?

- 10) Oliver was trying to expand his game collection. He bought 27 games from a friend and bought 22 more at a garage sale. If 17 of the games didn't work, how many good games did he end up with?

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
